Position Overview

This unpaid volunteer position is designed to align with academic credit requirements at your college or university. Students are responsible for coordinating with their academic advisors to ensure eligibility for credit.

Responsibilities

- Assist with voter outreach efforts, including phone banking, canvassing, or texting campaigns.
- Support event planning and execution, such as rallies, town halls, or fundraisers.
- Create and share campaign content on social media platforms to engage supporters.
- Conduct research on local issues, voter demographics, or opposing campaigns as needed.
- Attend team meetings and provide input on campaign strategies.
- Track volunteer hours and submit reports for college credit verification.

Qualifications

- Current enrollment as a college student at an accredited institution.
- Interest in politics, public policy, or civic engagement.
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal.

- Reliable, organized, and able to commit to a minimum of 2 hours per week.
- Access to a phone, computer, and internet connection for remote tasks (if applicable).
